Tour of the nuclear and the hydroelectric power plants of Fessenheim

Access requirements – Fessenheim NPP site

- ✓ Each participant must present the same identification document as the one given during the data collection process (original document, no copies allowed).
- ✓ Wear appropriate clothing: flat, closed shoes, long pants and long sleeves (arms and legs must be covered during the visit).
- ✓ Luggage, purses, cell phones, laptops, cameras, dictaphones or dangerous objects are **not allowed**. Please note that **there will be no lockers available on site!** Luggage and personal belongings can be left in the bus (the holds will be closed).
- ✓ Be in good physical condition. The 3.5 km tour includes several staircases. No possibility to sit down during the visit.
- ✓ Do not be too sensitive to vertigo.
- ✓ The sites are not accessible to people with reduced mobility.

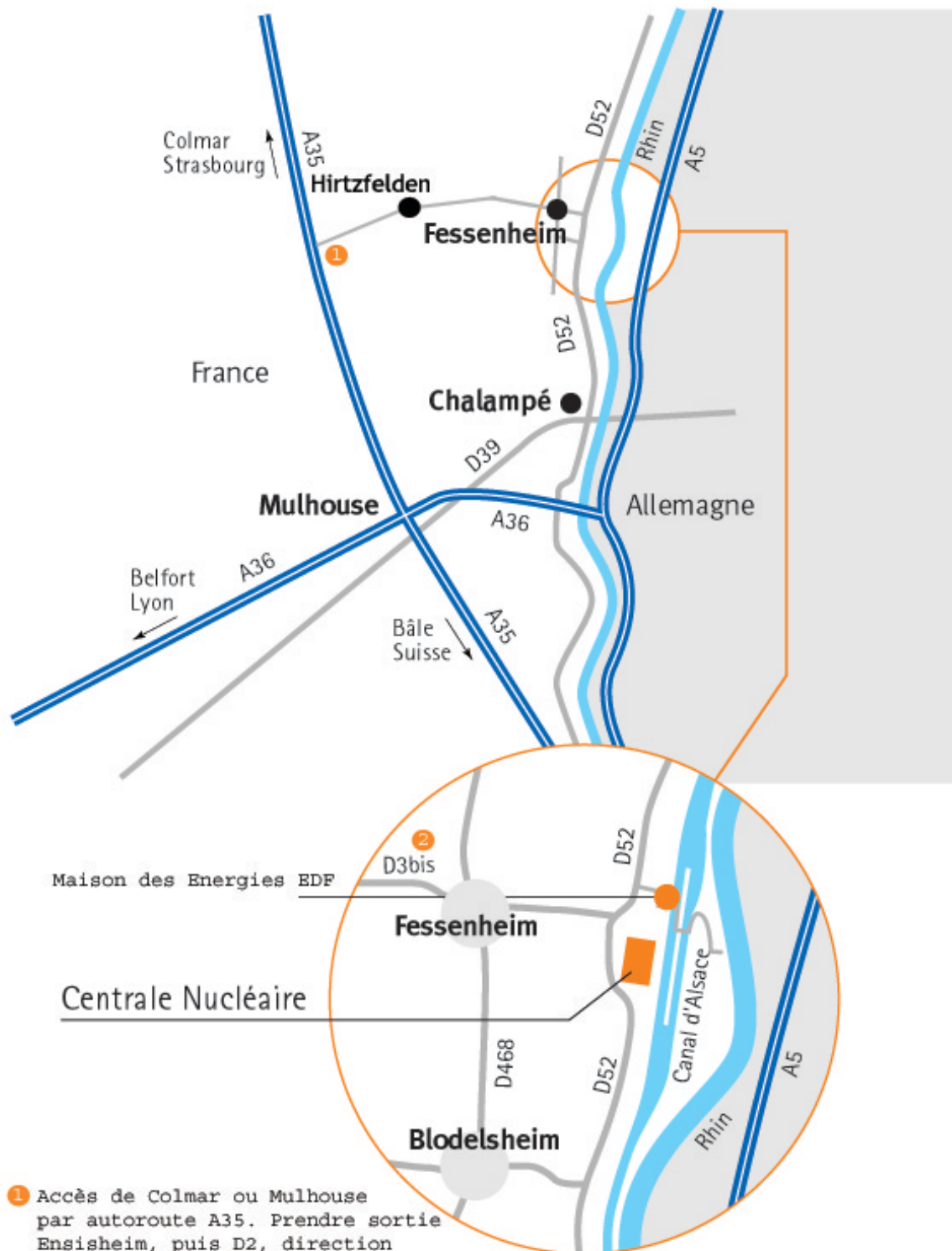
Agenda of the day

- 06:50** Meeting point at the Strasbourg train station: bus area at the very beginning of « Boulevard de Metz » (next to the train station – Lufthansa stop). Look for bus **Tribak Voyages**.
Participants' luggages can be safely stored in the hold of the bus.
